The relative importance of the main spheres of economic activity may be gauged from the pattern of distribution of workers (main + marginal) according to the broad four fold classification namely, cultivators, agricultural labourers, household industry workers and other workers. The economic activity in the district is primarily dependent on agriculture which is supported by the fact that the cultivators (26.04%) and agricultural labourers (37.38%) together constitute 63.42 per cent of the total workers of the district. The primary sector i.e., the agricultural sector has absorbed around two-third of the total workers of the district. Other workers (persons engaged in various types of activities other than cultivation, agricultural work and household industry work) are also in good number as their proportion to total workers in the district is to the extent of 32.07 percent. Household industry workers are meager 4.81 percent of the total workers. By and large, the same situation prevails in majority of the C.D. Blocks of the district so far the proportion of workers engaged in agricultural activities (cultivators and agricultural labourers) are concerned except in the case of Pakaur block where "other workers" are in considerable number constituting 66.20 percent of the total workers in the district. This may presumably be due to the headquarters town of Pakaur situated in this block where more opportunities are available for the people to be involved in economic activities other than agricultural pursuits.
